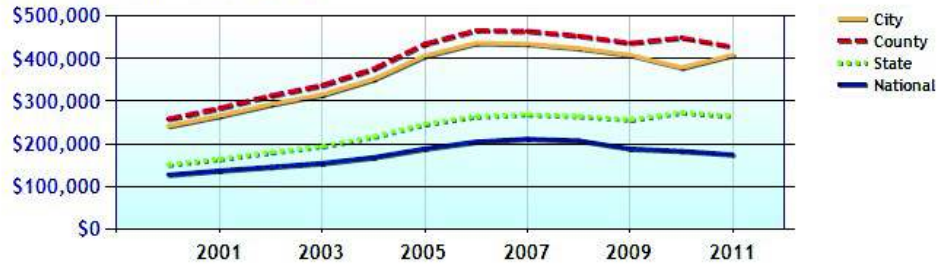


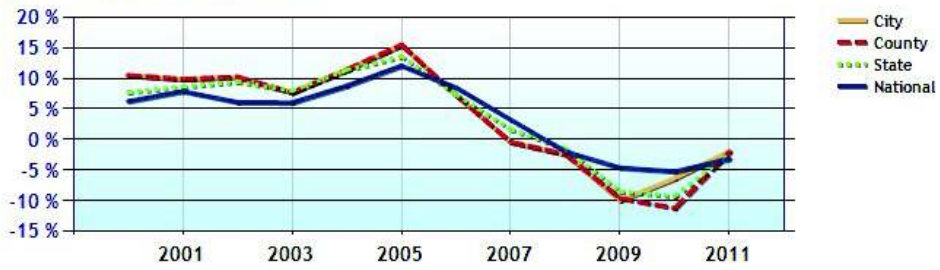

Median Home Value - Ten Year Chart



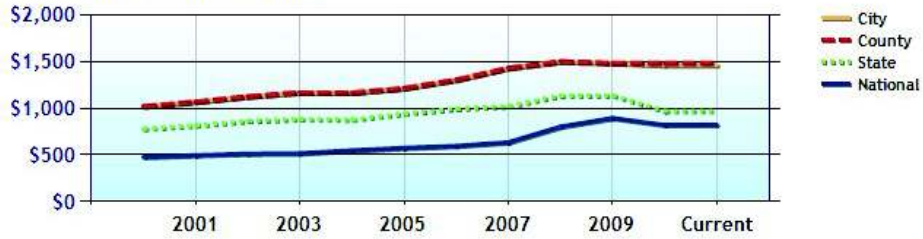

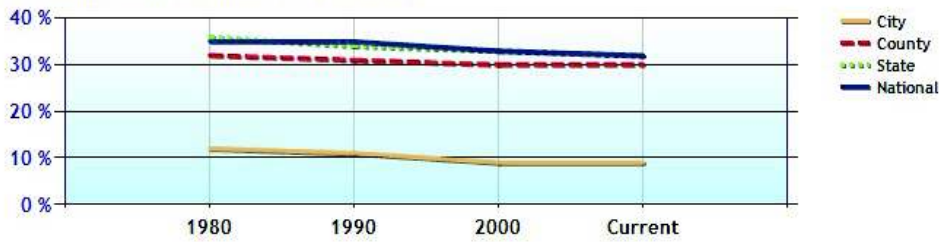

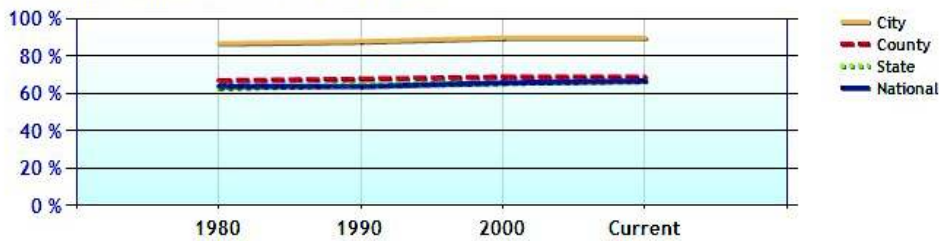
Average Rental Cost - Ten Year Chart



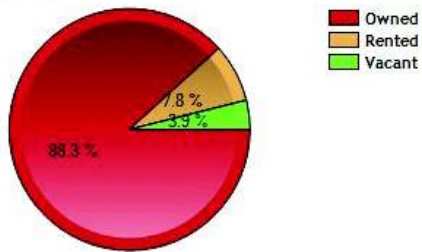
Percentage of Homes Rented - Thirty Year Chart



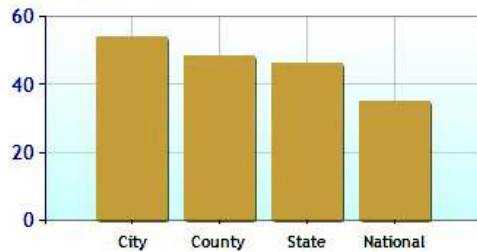
Percentage of Homes Owned - Thirty Year Chart

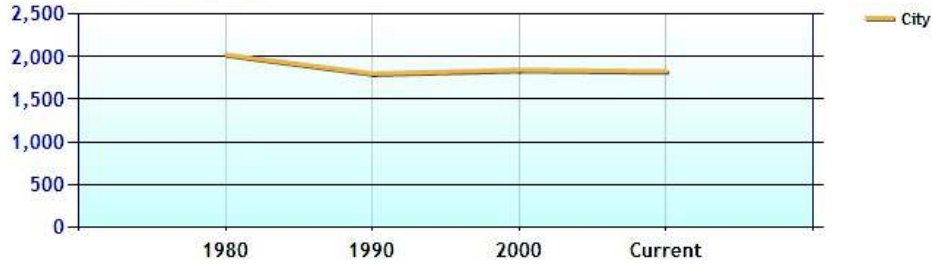

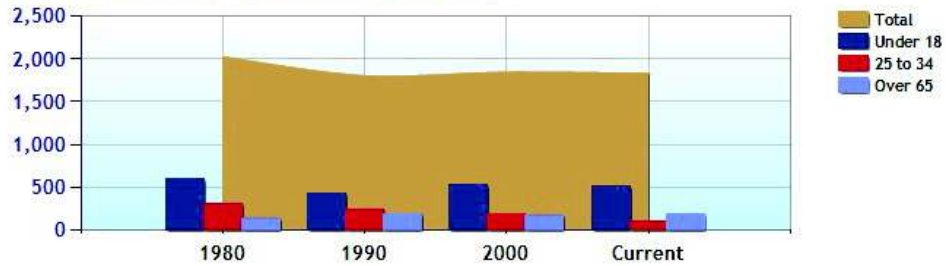

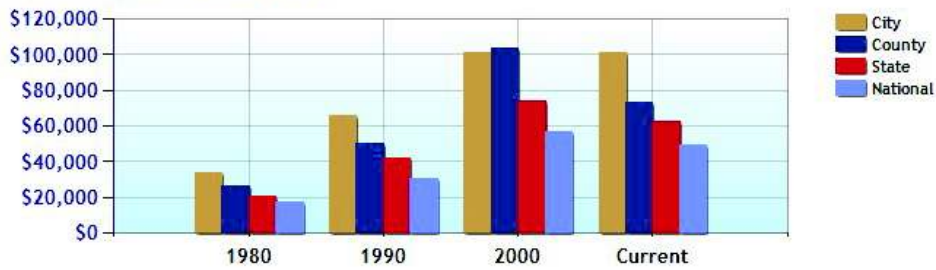
Population - Thirty Year Chart



Population Age vs Total Population - Thirty Year Chart

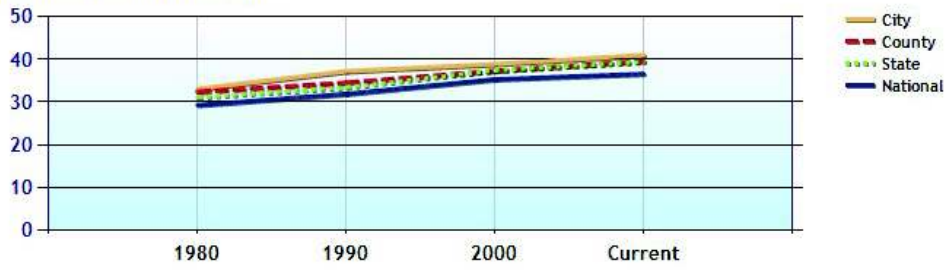


Household Income - Thirty Year Chart

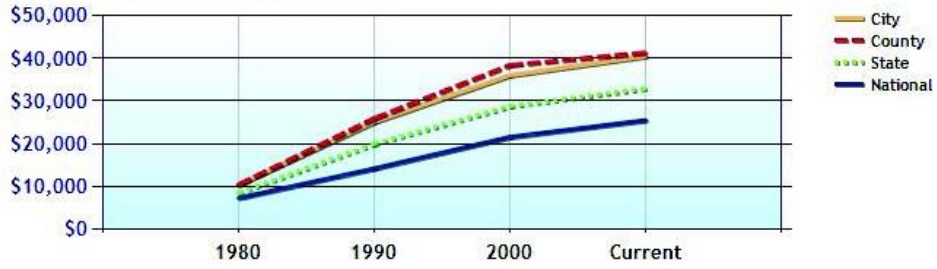

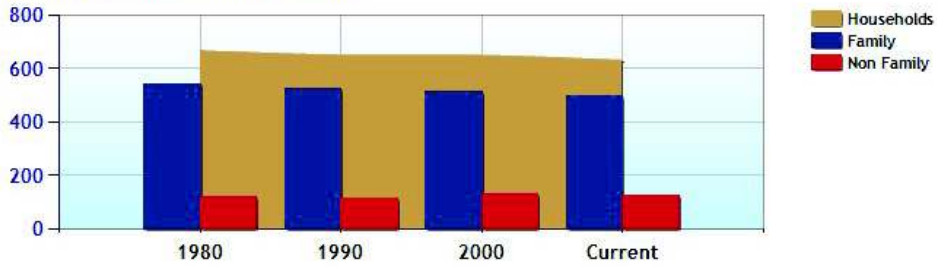
Median Age - Thirty Year Chart



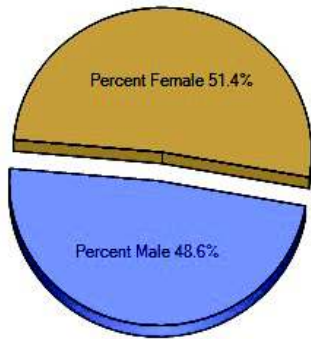
Median Personal Income - Thirty Year Chart



Household Breakdown - Thirty Year Chart



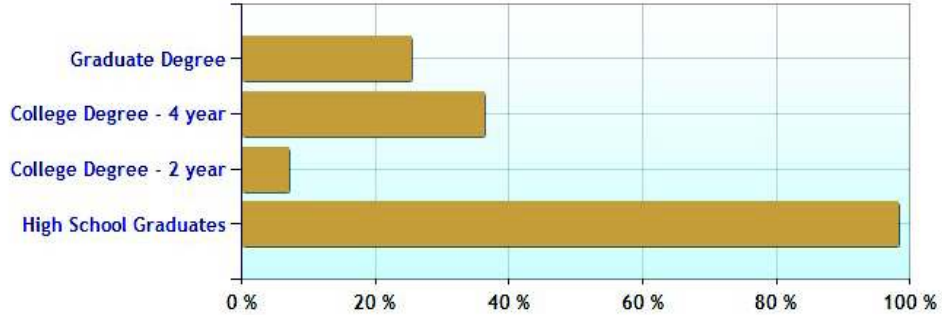

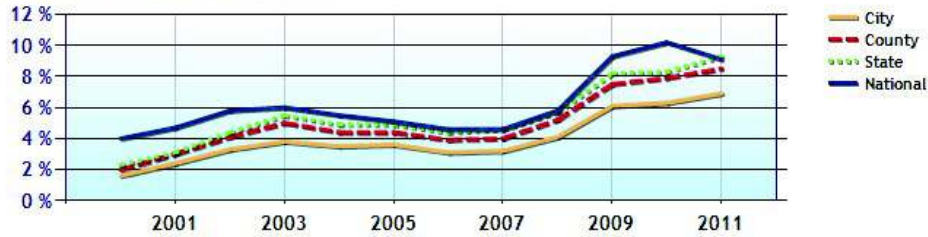

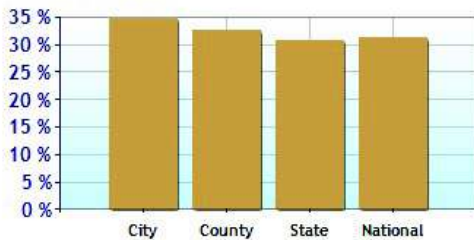
Unemployment Rate - Ten Year Chart



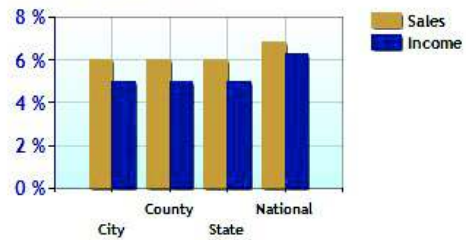
Job Growth - Ten Year Chart



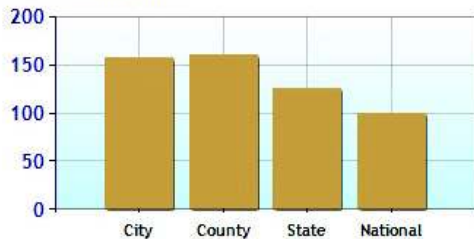
Future Job Growth



Sales and Income Tax



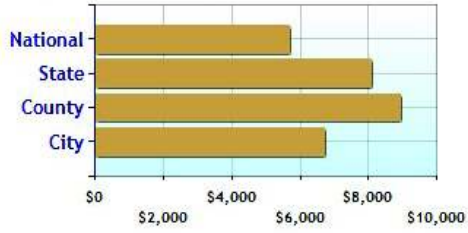

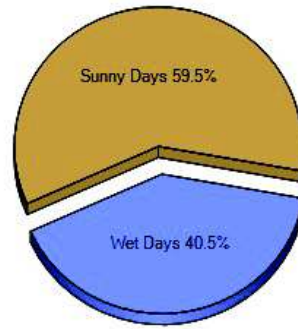
Temperature Extremes



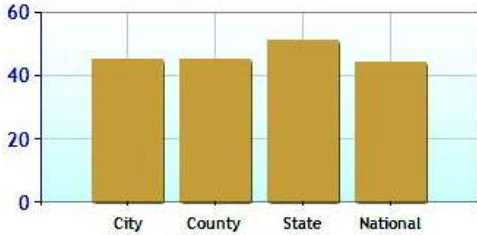

Sunny and Cloudy Days per Annum for Newtown



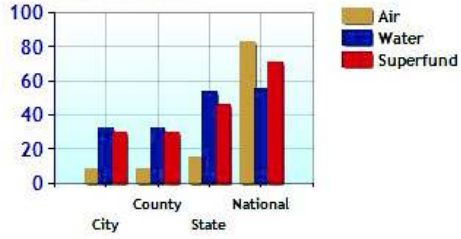

Commuting Methods for Newtown



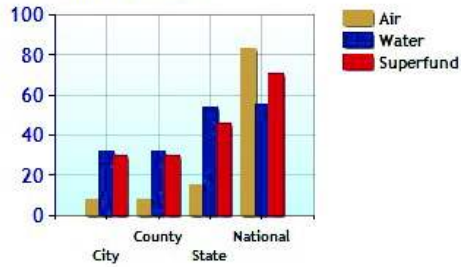

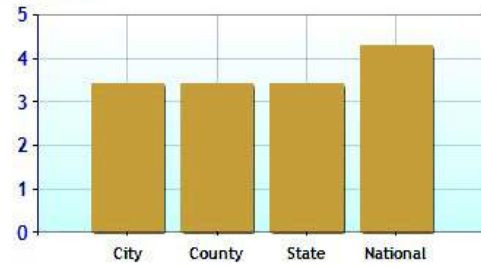

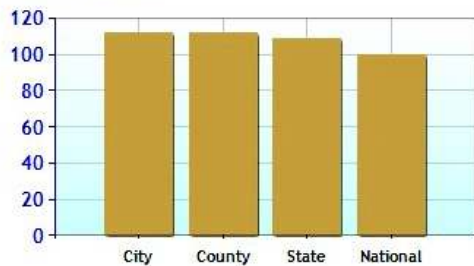
